



Cut Off Fixture

This type of street light will be used on major roads, and is designed to direct light onto the road and sidewalk. Cut-off fixtures do not emit light above the body of the fixture. They direct light to the ground, greatly reducing sky glow and unwanted light shining on drivers and nearby properties.



The Cobra-Head light fixture shines unwanted light in all directions and therefore does not meet County Standards.

Roadway Lighting Program

- Approximately 380 miles of the County's major roadways will be lighted.
- The lighting program is funded by gas taxes. There is no direct cost to property owners because major roads are used by everyone.
- Lighting design, installation and maintenance are provided by Florida Power or Orlando Utilities Commission.
- Roadways to be widened will be lighted upon construction.
- Standards
- Existing power poles will be used whenever possible.
- Concrete poles will be installed on existing roadways where power poles are not available.
- Aluminum poles will be used on roadway sections that do not have curb and gutter.

- Why are we installing streetlights?**
For traffic and pedestrian safety.
- What roads are included in the program?**
All major County roadways throughout Orange County.
- Which roads will be lighted first?**
The roads have been prioritized based on safety, traffic volume, and community centers.

- When will I get lights on my roadway?**

Most roads in the program will be lighted by 2004.

- How do I get lights on my street Roadway Lighting Program?**

If your County street is not in the program, it is probably a local, residential street. To apply for streetlights, send a written request for an MSTU:
