### **ORANGE COUNTY 2008-2009 ACTION PLAN AMENDMENT**

Orange County, Florida, expects to receive a special allocation of approximately \$2.5 million under the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The purpose of the HPRP is to provide financial assistance and services to either prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless, or help those who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly rehoused and stabilized.

To receive HPRP funds, Orange County must prepare and submit a substantial amendment to its 2008-2009 Action Plan. The amendment including the HPRP Plan will be available at the Orange County Housing and Community Development Division, located at 525 E. South Street in Orlando; and at the Orange County's website at: [www.ocfl.net/housing](http://www.ocfl.net/housing) from April 5-18, 2009. The amended Action Plan identifies the operational plan and strategies for affordable housing, social services and community development to be implemented during fiscal year 2008-2009.
