A Residential Foster Care Group Home for children birth to 17. The facility is comprised of seven 12-bed cottages; 5 cottages are used to house long-term foster and shelter care clients, 1 cottage is used as a 23-hour assessment center for children just removed from their homes, and 1 cottage is used as an independent living transition home for youth that have aged out of foster care. These children have not yet reached the level of self-sufficiency for them to live successfully on their own in the community. Children are provided an array of services including health, medical, nutritional, counseling, case management and recreational. Children also receive additional educational services through our newly constructed learning center.
