



Irrigation Tips:

1. Trees and shrubs that have been planted for 5 years or more typically need little or no water beyond normal rainfall.
2. Apply water in short cycles to allow absorption without runoff.
3. Adjust sprinkler heads routinely to keep water on the landscape and off pavement and structures.
4. Check your system monthly for broken heads or leaks that can turn an efficient system into a water guzzler.
