1. Acquisition Strategy

- a. Econlockhatchee River Hydrological Basin Corridors
- b. St. Johns River Hydrological Basin Corridors

Per the Committee meeting of September 20, 2006, the Committee requested additional refinement to proposed St. Johns River Corridor #2 prior to making a decision.
