




SANDBAG DISTRIBUTION

 Orange County distributes sandbags to Orange County's private property owners to alleviate flooding. Even though it is not the responsibility of the Orange County Roads & Drainage Division to provide flood protection to private property owners, there may be instances when this Division could respond and provide assistance to a limited number of flood protection requests.



When it becomes known that possible flooding is expected to occur, each Roads & Drainage Division facility will respond, resources allowing, to calls from citizens requesting sandbags to protect their personal property as follows:

- The maintenance facilities will deliver sandbags during an emergency. Each facility will staff one flatbed truck with driver and helper and one pickup truck with driver and helper. The activities of these teams will be coordinated and dispatched from the area maintenance facility.



- A maximum of 300 sandbags will be supplied per residence.

Fill bags only halfway to allow for folding. Fold top of bag down and rest bag on the folded top. Place bag with the folded top toward the flow of water to prevent bags from opening when water runs by them.

- At the time of delivery of sandbags, the attached receipt will be given to the customer to return to Orange County Public Works. This receipt tracks the number of bags given out and states that the customer is responsible for the disposal of the sandbags after the emergency passes.

- The placing of sandbags is the sole responsibility of the receiver. County staff may place sandbags for elderly or physically challenged individuals, if manpower is available and it is approved by the Division Manager.
