Provides services to Foster Care Youth that have aged out of traditional care and have not reached the developmental stage of self-sufficiency. The program objective is to empower youth to achieve self-sufficiency goals through specialized training, skill development and emotional support.

## **Services provided to**

-  Applicants between 18-20 years that have been in foster care and are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.
  -  Applicants must be attending school, agree to attend school full-time and work part-time or visa versa.
  -  Applicants must pass a basic screening consisting of a panel review.

## **Services include**

-  Counseling Services
  -  Case Management to assist in developing and completing Personal Success Plan, job search assistance, occupational assistance and career development, educational planning and assistance, financial aid/ scholarship resources assistance, and other referrals to community resources.
  -  Life/social skills classes: health and homecare, financial budgeting, checking and savings accounts, renting an apartment, time management, etiquette and etc.
  -  Internet access, computers and tutorial programs.
  -  Limited assistance with transportation.
