

Public Art Caches

Waverly Skyline

On the plaza at the core of Downtown Orlando, under the red awnings, is an information center with a scale model of downtown. Although the intersection is of Church Street and Orange Avenue, it is considered the “Main & Main” intersection of town. Inside the Information Center is a photograph entitled *Waverly Skyline*. This wide-format photograph was taken by local artist and politically-informed inner-city-business-owner David Van Gelder.

Stand back from the photograph to take it all in. If you are standing in the middle of the room, look to your right and you will find a red display case. Behind the middle door on the bottom is the cache. The cache is right next to a geo cache box. Make sure you record your find in the public art journal. Remember to act like you know what you are doing so as not to raise suspicions about your activity. Feel free to take one of the souvenir token from the bin beside the log-in book. The center is open Monday through Friday 9 am to 5 pm.
