







OAKS Community Intervention

The Oaks Community Intervention Program provides services to Orange County youth between ages 10-18 that have shown to be at a moderate-high risk of continued involvement with The Department of Juvenile Justice based on the PACT (Positive Action Change Tool) Assessment. The Oaks CIP provides family counseling to program participants.





The Oaks Program staff is comprised of Master's level Senior Children's Services Counselors and Juvenile Probation Officers and a Licensed Mental Health Counseling Services Supervisor. Service emphasis is placed on public safety while providing quality and intensive community-based services to families. The Oaks Program seeks to deter the involvement with negative peer groups while promoting and addressing pro-social skills, positive free time activities and educational services support while providing families the skills necessary to develop and sustain supportive family and community-based networks.

Services provided to

-  Youth ages 10-18 referred by The Department of Juvenile Justice for intensive counseling and probation services in the community and home.
 -  Youth residing in Orange County receiving current or are pending probation supervision services with The Department of Juvenile Justice.

-  Comprehensive family and mental health assessments.
-  Individual Case Planning Services.
-  Intensive Probation Supervision Services.
-  Promotion of positive community and extracurricular activities.
