



ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNER NOTARIZED STATEMENT OF NO OBJECTION FOR DOCK CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

As required by Section 15-347 of Orange County Code, the Environmental Protection Officer will send notice of receipt of an application for variance or waiver under the provisions of this ordinance by certified mail to the owners of the shoreline properties situated within 300 feet of the property on which the proposed is located. For waiver requests to the side setback requirements, the environmental protection officer will only send notice to the abutting shoreline property owner affected by the waiver request. The environmental protection officer may send additional notices to other shoreline property owners. The applicant, at his option, may supply notarized letters of no objection from the appropriate shoreline property owners.
