Holy Family Catholic Church (new sanctuary) Sixteen stained glass windows surround the sanctuary built in 1995. The large window above the main entrance is appropriately of the Holy Family - Joseph, Mary and Jesus. The men appear to be employed in carpentry and Mary appears to be weaving.

Three of the side windows feature saints. Three Irish saints, St. Patrick, St. Bridget and St. Columba fill one window along with the words "Faith, Hope, Love". They are a tribute to the Irish heritage of the pastor at the time of installation. To balance that window, three American saints fill a window on the opposite side. They are St. John Newman, St. Frances Cabrini and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. At the rear, in an overflow room that was a changing area for the altar servers before the [date]____ renovation and expansion, is a window with two youthful saints, St. Maria Goretti and St. Dominic Savio.

In a cove behind the Tabernacle are three windows depicting the Last Supper, the Divine Mercy of Jesus, and the Feeding of the Thousands. On the other side of the altar, in a cove behind the Baptistry is a window of the Baptism of Jesus. Centered behind the altar is a window depicting Jesus' Crucifixion.

In the cry room is Jesus with the Little Children. And the other windows in the sanctuary depict The Wedding at Cana, The Annunciation, The Nativity, The Ascension, Jesus and Mary at the Empty Tomb and Jesus the Good Shepherd.
