Systems, by [James Piercey](#), is a large, leaded-glass window in the Board of County Commissioners Chambers. The colorful lines and forms create a map-like image that is reminiscent of rivers, highways or other delivery systems that might be managed by county government. It was designed to complement the fountain outside the window and also incorporate some of the building brick work in a line of similarly shaped rectangles of glass to make it come alive. Transparent, translucent and opak glass combine with numerous clear glass lenses. Sadly, the window is normally shuttered in order to control the lighting in the televised chambers.
