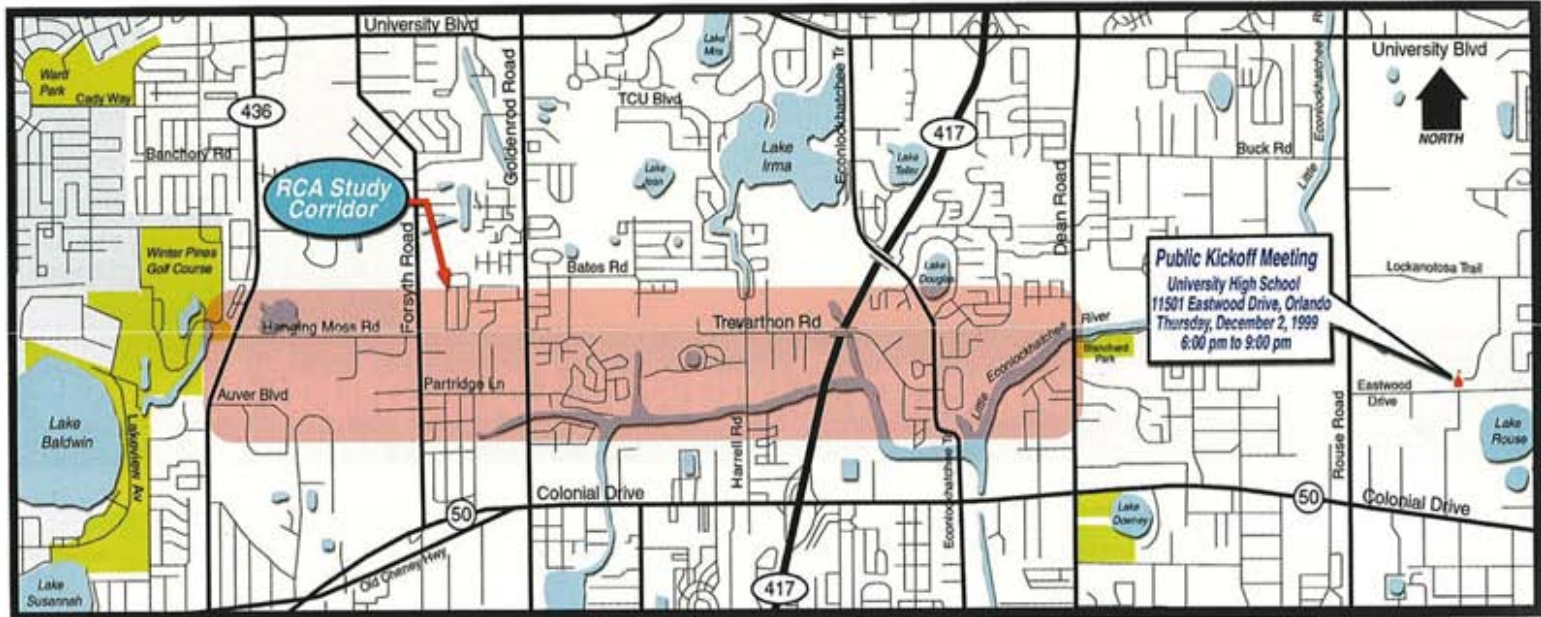
## East-West Connector Road RCA Study Begins

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Orange County has begun a Roadway Conceptual Analysis (RCA) study for a proposed east-west "connector" roadway between S.R. 436 (Semoran Boulevard) and Dean Road. The need for this new roadway, along with many other roadway improvements, was determined during the East Orange County Transportation Study conducted by Orange County last year. Although no specific alignment has been selected, the corridor for the East-West Connector Roadway is located north of S.R. 50 (Colonial Drive) and south of University Boulevard, between S.R. 436 and Dean Road, and is shown on the map below.

The purpose of this RCA study is to determine the best alignment for this proposed roadway based on engineering analysis, and the social, environmental and economic impacts to the community. The RCA study process seeks early and continued input from residents, property owners, business owners and public officials. Input will be sought through a series of public meetings and workshops throughout the duration of the study.



## First Public Meeting - December 2, 1999

You are invited to the **Project Kickoff Meeting** to be held on **Thursday, December 2, 1999** at University High School, located at 11501 Eastwood Drive, Orlando. This informal open-house meeting will begin at **6:00 pm** and last until approximately **9:00 pm**. A brief **presentation** will be given at **7:00 pm** which will provide an **overview** of the **East Orange County Transportation Study** as background information. This will be followed by an overview of the East West Connector Road RCA study process and project schedule. Aerial graphics of the study corridor area will be on display. Your input and suggestions regarding the potential improvements will help determine the alternatives that will be identified and evaluated as part of this study. A second public meeting will be held after the first of the year to present **alternative alignments** being considered. A third public meeting will be held in late Spring or early Summer of 2000 to present the results of the analysis. A final Public Hearing will be held in the Fall of 2000 to present the recommended alternative.

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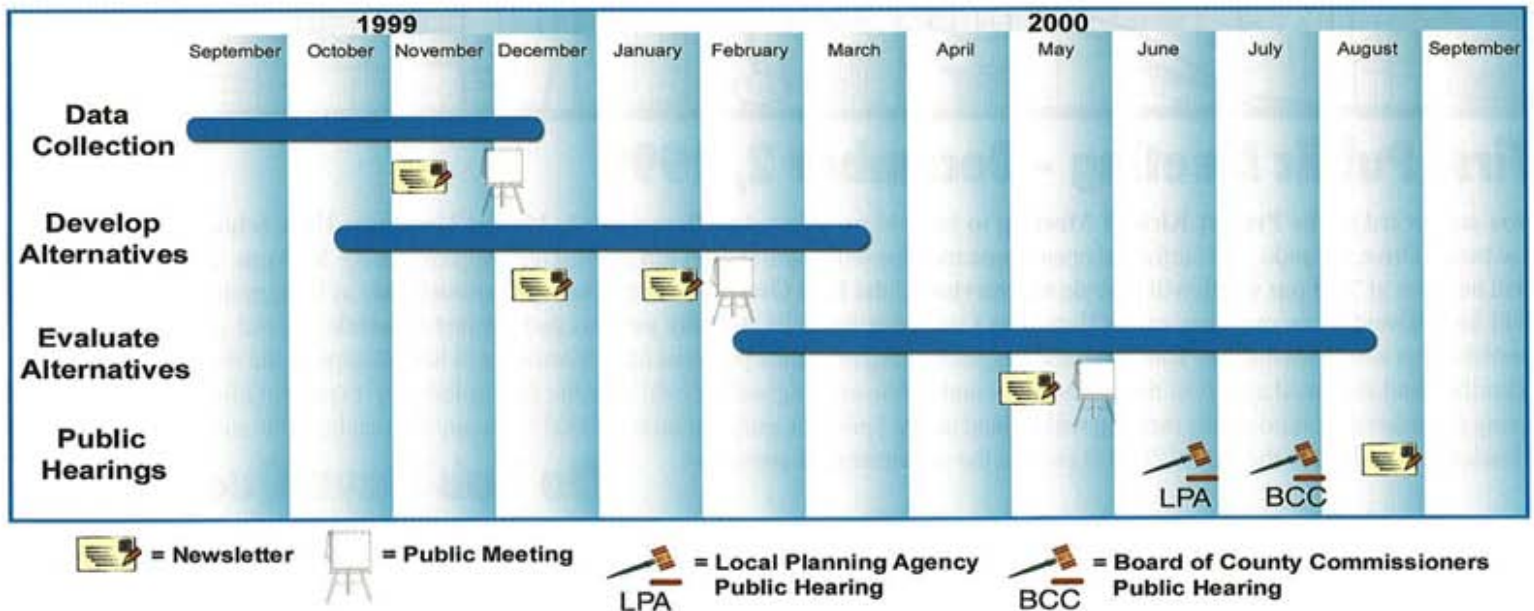
