
## **KEY PROJECT UPDATES**

- The contractor has placed silt fence along the perimeter of the project per plan. They have mobilized construction equipment to the jobsite including a Frontend Loader, Excavator, and End Dump Truck. They have constructed two soil-tracking devices at each entrance gate (Robinson & Livingston).
- ► Hoses have been delivered, fused together (this process is time consuming but necessary), and placed in preparation of pumping water. 2-12" pumps are in place. 2-8" pumps are on site ready to begin pumping water from the North and South ponds into the West Pond.
- A perimeter fence has been installed around the Eagle's nest on top of Cell Tower.
- Contractor has begun installing check dams in canal, in preparation for pumping. They have made repairs to existing Type B fence and silt fence that was cut/damaged by people entering site, in South/West corner of project. As soon as the Dewatering Plan is approved by Orange County, they will begin pumping down the North and South ponds.
