TEEN VOLUNTEERS

Teens, age 16 or older, can volunteer in a variety of ways with Orange County Parks and Recreation. If a student is under the age of 16 and wants to volunteer, he/she must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times during their volunteer opportunity.

- Earn community service hours for school, college entrance and scholarship requirements

To become an Orange County Parks and Recreation STARS Teen, Adult or Group Volunteer, you must complete a Volunteer Application and a Florida Department of Law Enforcement Background Screening Request Form (background check is free of charge). Forms can be turned in at the park where you want to volunteer.
