

CONDITIONS OF COUNTY PROBATION

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE CONDITIONS MAY RESULT IN A VIOLATION OF YOUR PROBATION.

1. You will notify your probation officer within seventy-two (72) hours if you change your residence or your employment status. You will not leave the county of your residence without the consent of your probation officer.
2. Each month, you will make a full and truthful report to your probation officer on the form provided for that purpose, unless otherwise directed by your officer.
3. You are prohibited from possessing, carrying or owning any firearm unless authorized by the court and consented to by your probation officer.
4. You will not violate any laws while on probation. A conviction in a court of law shall not be necessary in order to constitute a violation of your probation. If you are arrested, or given a notice to appear, you will notify your probation officer within seventy-two (72) hours.
5. You will not associate with persons engaged in criminal activities.
6. You will maintain full time employment at a lawful occupation, or maintain full time student status insofar as possible, and support any legal dependents to the best of your ability.
7. You will promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries directed to you by the court or the probation officer and allow the officer to visit in your home, at your employment site, and elsewhere, and you will comply with all instructions given to you by your probation officer.
8. You will pay \$50.00 per month to the **Community Corrections Division Probation Unit** to help defray the cost of supervision, as provided in Section 948.09, Florida Statute.
9. Unless prohibited from consuming alcoholic beverages by a special condition in this order, you will not consume alcoholic beverages to the extent that you become intoxicated.
10. You will not possess, use, or consume any unlawful substance. Controlled substances, which are prescribed by a doctor, may be used only in accordance with a legal prescription.
11. You will submit to random testing as directed by your Probation Officer or the professional staff of the treatment center where you are receiving treatment to determine the presence or use of alcohol, controlled or unlawful substances.
12. You will complete and satisfy all probation conditions no later than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of your probationary period. You will comply with all court ordered enrollment and/or completion dates. Further, you will provide your probation officer with all requested documentation regarding compliance not later than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of your probation.
