The Orange County Board of County Commissioners will conduct a public hearing pertaining to Public Nuisance Abatement regarding a proposed ordinance amending and retitling Chapter 28, Article IV of the Orange County Code; modifying provisions pertaining to the intent, short title, definitions, jurisdiction of the nuisance abatement board, the conduct of hearings before the nuisance abatement board, the administrative fines ordered by the nuisance abatement board, and the liens that can be placed upon properties as a result of ongoing nuisance activity; and providing for an effective date.
