| This ordinance amends and repeals certain provisions of Chapter 38 (“Zoning”) of the Orange County Code to provide consistency with the Comprehensive Plan and new land development regulations known as “Orange Code” (proposed new Orange County Code Chapter 40) and reenacting certain provisions as new Orange County Code Chapter 39 (“Planned Development”) to be considered in conjunction with the adoption of Comprehensive Plan Amendment 2023-1-C-CP-1 – An Evaluation and Appraisal-based Amendment updating the “Orange County Comprehensive Plan 2010-2030 - Destination 2030” and renaming it the “Vision 2050: Orange County Comprehensive Plan.” |
