Pass a background check





These include: Communications, teamwork, firehose deployment and control, hazard identification and mitigation, search and rescue, and first aid.

The Explorer Cadets participate in a number of events that have a direct benefit to the community and to the fire service. Community service hours are tracked by the program coordinator and may be used towards the Bright Futures Scholarship Program.



SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

Explorer Cadets participate in a variety of social activities that include field trips, Explorer Cadet Orientation Academy, lock-ins (a special event to help an Explorer Cadet to understand the day in the life a firefighter, fundraising activities, and sometimes a trip for ice cream.
