All applications for development permits, including the application referenced below, are governed by Section 125.022, Florida Statutes (FS). Paragraphs (2) through (4) of Section 125.022 specify application review and response timeframes and other limitations. As such, Orange County's ability to request additional information to evaluate a permit application, as well as an applicant's opportunity to respond, is limited, unless the applicant and County mutually agree to waive the limitations in writing.

Note: If the review of an application requires more than three Request for Additional Information (RAI) letters, due to the statutory limitations, the application will be processed as-is and may be denied and closed if the statutory limitations have not been waived. If closed, a new permit application will be required including the required application fee.

I, the applicant for the subject permit, hereby understand and acknowledge the ability to waive timeframes and other limitations pursuant to the statute noted above, and declare as follows:

Yes, I agree to waive the timeframes and other limitations referenced in Section 125.022(2) through (4), FS, as related to Application Number _____.

Note: Pursuant to internal policy, EPD will still adhere to a 30-day review timeframe when RAI responses are received, even if the applicant has waived the limitations of the statute. However, if no activity (e.g., applicant/agent responses, emails, phone conversations, etc.) occurs within a six-month timeframe and no progress has been made to move the project forward, EPD will close the application due to lack of responsiveness.
